- _____ JCTA Skin Typing Form (Form # JCTA-8366) must be completed for each tanning client and kept on file for a minimum of 2 years.
- _____ Spray tanning warranty must be signed and returned. (If applicable)
- _____ Eye Protection /goggles will be sold or provided by Tanning Studio and use is mandatory by client.
- _____ All washing machine hoses and other plumbing fixture hoses must be inspected and checked for maintenance every 5 years and replaced if leaking.
- _____ All washing machine hoses and other plumbing fixture hoses must be replaced every 10 years – braided hoses are recommended.
- _____ All tanning beds are to be inspected every two years and a schedule of inspection kept on file – inspections may be conducted according to manufacturer's equipment manual.
